The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) Utility Engineering and Surveying Institute (UESI) holds an annual competition on the regional and national level. This competition evaluates students' knowledge in land surveying off and on the field. Teams are tasked with drafting a topographic map for the office component, and then subject to a variety of field tasks in a time-constrained environment. Students are given the opportunity to apply problem-solving techniques to real-life scenarios.
