The Education Committee is a standing Committee of CLSA. We are planning some exciting work this year. A few of our charges include:

- working with BPELSG to revitalize meaningful curriculum for LS review courses and updating the CLSA LS exam review manual;
- introducing CLSA members to the Certified Survey Technician (CST) Program and working with NSPS to revise, update and prepare a plan for implementation of the Program in partnership with CLSA;
- working with the Operating Engineers Local 3 and Local 12 training programs in CA to support those programs and offer CLSA members as educators;
- building a database of educational institutions and STEM programs that are delving into surveying and mapping either through the traditional engineering pathways or newer geospatial sciences;
- serving as liaisons to the student chapters and developing a framework that will assist local chapters to sponsor educational institutions and STEM programs; and
- developing surveying and mapping lesson plan curriculum use at the middle school level offering CLSA members as "Teachers for a Day" and for outreach and career presentations consistent with updated grade level standards.
- working with universities and community colleges in California to develop educational opportunities for students and surveyors in a two-way manner.
